

Federal Direct Loan Entrance Interview & Master Promissory Note

Federal Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans

Students must complete a Master Promissory Note and an online session called a Loan Entrance Interview in order for their Federal Direct Student Loans to fund.

In order to complete the steps below you are required to have a Department of Education (DOE)-issued FSA ID. If you do not have your FSA ID you can access one by going to https://fsaid.ed.gov/npas/index.htm

Please note that these loans are in the student's name and the student should be the person completing the steps below.

- 1. Go to www.studentloans.gov and sign-in with your "FSA ID."
- 2. Enter your sign-in information.
- 3. Click on "Complete Counseling."
- 4. Read the introductory information and click on "Entrance Counseling."
- 5. Select Your School. Select Student Type. Continue.
- 6. Carefully read each page, answer the corresponding questions, and click "Continue" to go to the next section of the online session.
- 7. After you've gone through all the necessary pages and answered all questions successfully, click "Submit Counseling".
- 8. Select the "View Completed Counseling" link and print for your records. The school receives electronic confirmation of completion.
- 9. Next, select "Complete Master Promissory Note" (MPN).
- 10. Review the "View What You Need" page and be sure to have the information needed before beginning.
- 11. Under "Select the Direct Loan you would like to receive" choose Subsidized/Unsubsidized.
- 12. Follow all of the on-screen instructions and be sure to sign electronically and submit at the end.
- 13. Be sure to print a copy of the MPN for your records. The school receives electronic confirmation of completion.
- 14. Be sure to View/Print Borrower's Rights and Responsibilities for Direct Subsidized and Unsubsidized Loans.
