Minor Requirements (Standard Route)

The Archaeology Minor requires 6 credits, and minors can pursue either the traditional or the archaeological science track.

Required courses include:

- 1 Gateway Course
- 2 x 0.5 credit ARCP 310 (*must* be taken twice) **OR** 1 Elective credit w/ Chair approval**
- 4 area distribution courses:
 - Classical Archaeology
 - Anthropology
 - Art History
 - Method and Theory

**Archaeological Science Minors

- should plan to take a 300-level Lab course as one of their courses.

-can apply one extra-departmental science course for the Elective credit if they can demonstrate relevance to their project work in ARCP

Minor Requirements (ARCP/CoDES Linked Minor)

The Linked ARCP/CoDES Minor requires 7 credits, integrating CoDES required design/engineering courses with courses in archaeological analysis.

Required courses include:

- ARCP 204 Intro to Archaeology
- 3 CoDES Required Courses
 - IDEAS 170
 - IDEAS 180
 - IDEAS 220
- 1 ARCP course introducing archaeological experimentation
- 2 ARCP project-based courses

We recommend that students pursuing the linked minor take ARCP 204 and one of their IDEAS electives in their first year.
