REQUIREMENTS

CANDIDATES SHOULD PREPARE UP TO 15 MINUTES OF MUSIC WHICH WILL SHOWCASE THEIR HEYBOARD TALENTS AND UERSATILITY AT THE PIANO, ORGAN, OR HARPSICHORD, IN A SOLO OR COLLABORATIUE CAPACITY (PLAYING WITH ANY OTHER INSTRUMENT, OR IN A CHAMBER ENSEMBLE SETTING). COMPOSITIONS FROM DIFFERENT STYLES, ERAS, OR GENRES ARE DESIRABLE. THE COLLABORATIUE REPERTOIRE NEEDS TO FEATURE A HEYBOARD PART THAT IS DEMANDING AND ELABORATE. NOT EUERY ACCOMPANIMENT WILL QUALIFY AS SUCH, THEREFORE CANDIDATES ARE ENCOURAGED TO CONSULT THEIR PRIVATE LESSONS INSTRUCTOR, OR THE MEMBERS OF THE TISHLER COMPETITION COMMITTEE, WHEN IN DOUBT. THE AUDITION WILL BE EVALUATED ON OVERALL HEYBOARD ARTISTRY, ENSEMBLE, COMMUNICATION, INTERPRETATION OF THE SUBTLETIES AND NUANCES OF EACH COMPOSITION, AND DEMONSTRATION OF MUSICAL IMAGINATION. PIECES NEED NOT BE MEMORIZED. THE TOP PRIZE IS \$500, BUT MAY BE SPLIT AT THE DISCRETION OF THE JURY.
